


# What Makes Wobble Wedges Work So Well?



#### You Can Stack'em

You can stack them short or stack them really tall. You can stack them upside down or right side up. You can stack them flat or stack them on an incline. No matter which way you stack them, Wobble Wedges deep interlocking ridges grab tight and stay put.

All Wobble Wedges have a unique grab bar to make to make it easy to adjust in hard to reach places.

Wobble Wedges helps you hold things in place so you can use your hands for other things such as lining up wood joints, or holding an automotive part in place while inserting bolts, or holding up a door while you reset the hinges.

## In The Home

- Stabilize wobbly tables, desks, cabinets, lamps, antique furniture, potted plants, statues, sculptures.
- Straightens bookshelves, entertainment centers or furniture that sits on the carpet tack strip and leans into the room
- Level refrigerators, stoves, dishwashers and cabinets so doors open and shut properly.
- Level and stabilize wobbly toilets
- Adjust slope of a pedestal sink or tub so it drains well
- Wedge old casement windows tight to prevent rattles
- Wedge older windows to hold them open
- Silence rattling water pipes & furnace cabinet panels
- Wedge whole house ceiling fan vents tight to prevent rattles
- Tilt your computer monitor to a better viewing angle
- Stabilize stone or concrete step




#### In The Patio & Yard

- Adjust the flow of water in your fountain for the perfect look and sound.
- Stabilize patio furniture
- Wedge table umbrella tight so it won't spin or rock
- Stabilize & plumb planter boxes and yard sculptures
- Level block or concrete bricks when installing a garden wall
- Stabilize stone, block or concrete steps
- Level outdoor grills
- Wedge wood siding up enough to let it breath in high humidity areas
- Tighten fence rails



## For DIY & Shop Projects

- Level and stabilize shop tools...table saw, band saw, workbench
- Use as a disposable glue scraper....glue won't adhere to it
- Install, level and plumb shop cabinets
- Level granite countertops seams for a perfect fit
- Level & stabilize workpieces
- Temporarily tighten and secure cabinet joints or other wood joints while gluing.
- Use a combination of rigid and flexible Wobble Wedges as non-marring clamping pads.

- Use as a handy kerf guard to prevent binding when making a long saw cut in wood.
- Use as a handy spacing guide when installing decking.

- Stabilize portable steps
- Stabilize picnic tables
- Reduce rattles and squeaks by tightening or separating cabinet panels or other objects that "shimmy" when vehicle is in motion.
- Level camping stoves



#### Art & Craft Uses

- Use as a prop shim to tilt objects into just the right place or lighting to make a great photograph.
- Temporarily hold craft items in place to experiment how it looks in this way or that.
- Temporarily hold craft items in place while you glue or fasten them together
- Use a a disposable glue spreader
- Makes a interesting pallet knife for oil or acrylic paintings

## Office & Home Office Uses

- Level file cabinets so the drawers don't slide shut or open while you are trying to file.
- Level, stabilize & plumb bookshelves, desks, credenzas, lab equipment, and light warehouse shelving
- Adjust & stabilize cubicle enclosures



## Personal Entertainment

- Put a Wobble Wedges in the heels of your partners shoes so the are "inclined to agree with you"
- Rub two Wobble Wedges to make musical rhythm. They make the sound of a tiny washboard.
- Become the hero of the moment...Keep Wobble Wedges on your key chain so you always have an instant solution to those annoying problems that always show up.
